

Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Rocklea to Darra – Stage 1

Temporary closure of the pedestrian and cycle underpass, Oxley Creek Bridge

December 2017

The information below relates to upcoming Ipswich Motorway upgrade works.

The pedestrian and cyclist underpass at the Oxley Creek bridge (between Factory Road Loop, Oxley and Boundary Road, Rocklea), will be temporarily closed between 15 January 2018 until project completion (late 2020).

This temporary closure is needed to allow for bridge construction works and to ensure the safety of pedestrians and cyclists travelling through the motorway construction zone. During construction, cyclist and pedestrian connectivity across the Ipswich Motorway will be maintained via the pedestrian crossing points at the Oxley Road roundabout.

Notification signs advising of the closure will be installed from mid-December.

The completed project will include improved cyclist facilities on the northern service road, including a section of separated cycle path between the Granard Road interchange and the Oxley Creek floodplain.
