

Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Rocklea to Darra – Stage 1

Night works on the Ipswich Motorway (westbound) between Granard Road entry ramp and the Ipswich Motorway exit ramp at Randolph Street, Rocklea.

May 2019

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) advise that night works will occur on the Ipswich Motorway westbound lanes (see attached map) from **mid-May to August 2019**.

A single westbound lane will operate from **Sunday to Thursday 8pm to 5am** from the Granard Road entry ramp to the Randolph Street off ramp (towards Ipswich). Access to local businesses and the Randolph Street off ramp will be maintained. Traffic control will be in place for safety.

The work will be noisy as excavators, profilers and jack hammers will be used to remove old concrete and asphalt from the roadway. Water trucks will be used to control dust.

Please obey reduced speed limits and signage advising of the changed traffic conditions in place.
