# Intersection upgrade – Reedy Creek Road and Bermuda Street

#### March 2017

# About the project:

The Department of Transport and Main Roads will soon commence work to upgrade the intersection of Reedy Creek Road and Bermuda Street, Burleigh Waters.

The upgrade will reduce traffic congestion and queuing on Reedy Creek Road (east), improve traffic flows through the intersection and increase safety for motorists, pedestrians and cyclists.

Construction work will take place mainly at night to minimise disruption to motorists, particularly during peak hours.

### Work details:

- Introduction of an additional westbound right turn lane from Reedy Creek Road (east) into Bermuda Street (north).
- Changes to left turn from Kortum Drive into Reedy Creek Road to allow for safer merging of vehicles.
- Changes to left turn from Bermuda Street (south) into Reedy Creek Road (west) to allow for safer merging of vehicles.
- Reconstruction of existing traffic islands.
- Upgrade of traffic signals.
- Revised line marking and updated signage.

#### **Timeframes:**

- Construction is scheduled to commence early April 2017 and expected to be completed late June 2017 (subject to weather).
- Night works will take place between the hours of 8pm to 4am, Monday to Friday.
- Every effort will be made to minimise noise from heavy machinery by restricting its use wherever possible to 8pm 11pm.

## **Expected impacts:**

- Changed traffic conditions on Reedy Creek Road and Bermuda Street, including temporary lane closures and speed restrictions during construction work.
- Pedestrian crossings may be temporarily impacted. Pedestrians should proceed with caution through the work zones.
- Advance warning signs will be in place and traffic controllers will direct traffic through the work zone.
- Reverse warning alerts and flashing light beacons on construction vehicles are a safety requirement and will be used at all times during work hours.
- Lighting towers will be directed away from residences and businesses.
