Southport-Burleigh Road network improvement program Central section (Vespa Crescent to Monaco Street Bridge)

Works to upgrade the central section of Southport– Burleigh Road (Bundall Road), between Vespa Crescent and Monaco Street Bridge, are progressing.

As part of the upgrade, the right-hand turn lane from Bundall Road into Binda Place will be permanently removed.

Permanent access changes for Binda Place will be in place from Monday 14 November 2016. Please note left-hand turn access to Binda Place will be maintained for motorists travelling southbound on Bundall Road.

As part of these works, APA Gas will be undertaking night works to relocate a gas main situated at the entry to Binda Place from Bundall Road.

It is important to note that wet weather, contractor and site conditions may change this work schedule.

Location and timing

Local access will be maintained for residents whilst the works are conducted.

Access changes will be in place from:

Meanwhile night works will take place from:

6pm Monday 14
November – 6am
Tuesday 15 November

What to expect

During works, local residents and road users can expect:

- Audible construction noise: Heavy machinery will be in use during the work period, along with reversing beepers and flashing lights.
- Lane closures: Lane closures will be in place on Binda Place. One lane will be maintained for entering and exiting Binda Place for duration of gas works.

- Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes in the work zone – stay alert and obey all directional signage.
- Changed traffic conditions and reduced speed limits within the work zones.
