NIGHT WORKS

November 2016

Southport-Burleigh Road network improvement program Southern section (Fremar Street to Rudd Street)

Please note due to external influences, the majority of scheduled nightworks have been delayed until next week.

Previous works included the demolition of the median concrete barrier between Monaco Street and the Nerang River Bridge southern abutment, as well as removal of median island between Nerang River bridge northern abutment and Boomerang Crescent. Now that this is complete, asphalt works and linemarking will be undertaken in this area.

Where possible, work is being carried out during the day behind barriers however for safety and traffic management reasons, some work must be undertaken at night.

As well as minimising delays to the travelling public, this work is being undertaken at night to ensure a safe environment for motorists, pedestrians, cyclists, and construction workers.

Night works will generally take place between 7pm and 6am. Where possible, noisy works will be scheduled to occur early in the work period.

Timing


There will be minimal night works completed this week, with Traffic Signal adjustments at the Rudd St intersection on the night of the 7/11, and a concrete pour at the Albert Park Lagoon Bridge for Widening works on the night of the 9/11. Following that, night works will be undertaken for one week, commencing on:

6pm Monday 14
November to 6am
Saturday 19 November
2016

It is important to note this work schedule depends on wet weather, contractor and other site conditions and may change without notice.

What to expect

During night works local residents, businesses and road users can expect:



- Audible construction noise: Heavy machinery will be in use during the work period. Other activities such as tree trimming, concrete cutting, and the loading and unloading of materials will produce audible noise.
- Changed traffic conditions: Reduced speed limits and traffic control will be in place throughout the work zone. Road users are asked to follow signage and take care while travelling through the area.
- Single lane closures in both directions: Lane closures will be in place in the work zone.
 Motorists can expect minor traffic delays
- Reversing beepers and flashing lights: These are a safety requirement and will be used at all times during work hours.
