Southport-Burleigh Road network improvement program Central section (Vespa Crescent to Monaco Street Bridge)

Night works will be undertaken to progress works on the central section of Southport–Burleigh Road.

The works will include:

- Installation of a crane at Monaco Street Bridge in preparation for widening works, which will involve increasing available traffic lanes from four lanes to six.
- Cut over of gas pipes on Bundall Road. Construction will begin on the western side of Bundall Road before crossing to the eastern side at the northern abutment of Monaco Street Bridge. These works will finish at the southern abutment of the Monaco Street Bridge. The gas cut over works will be undertaken by APA Gas, allowing for the connection of a new gas main.
- Asphalt will also be poured on both the northbound and southbound lanes between Monaco Street and Fremar Street. One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained.

Where possible, work is being carried out during the day behind barriers however for safety and traffic management reasons, some work must be undertaken at night.

As well as minimising delays to the travelling public, this work is being undertaken at night to ensure a safe environment for motorists, pedestrians, cyclists, and construction workers.

Timing

Night works will be undertaken from:

- **7pm Monday 12
December to 6am
Saturday 17 December
2016**

It is important to note this work schedule depends on wet weather, contractor and other site conditions and may change without notice.

Night works will generally take place between 7pm and 6am. Where possible, noisy works will be scheduled to occur early in the work period.

What to expect

During night works local residents, businesses and road users can expect:

- **Audible construction noise:** Heavy machinery will be in use during the work period. Other activities such as the loading and unloading of materials will produce audible noise.
- **Changed traffic conditions:** Reduced speed limits and traffic control will be in place throughout the work zone. Road users are asked to follow signage and take care while travelling through the area.
- **Single lane closures in both directions:** Lane closures will be in place in the work zone. Motorists can expect minor traffic delays
- **Reversing beepers and flashing lights:** These are a safety requirement and will be used at all times during work hours.
