START OF CONSTRUCTION

Southport–Burleigh Road Upgrade - Northern section - North Street to Vespa Crescent January 2016

From January 2016, BMD Constructions will start work to upgrade a 5-kilometre section of Southport-Burleigh Road (High Street, Ferry Road and Bundall Road) between North Street, Southport and Vespa Crescent, Bundall.

Construction starts January 2016 and is expected to be complete in early 2017.


Work involves

- The creation of a third traffic lane in each direction by removing the on-street parking
- A shared off-road cycle and pedestrian pathway along most of the eastern side
- Upgrades to two bridges to accommodate the third lane
- Improvements to intersections including the installation of traffic signals at Winchester Street, Yacht Street, Cotlew Street East/Skiff Street and Shaw Street
- Relocation of some services including power and water
- Revised line marking and signage.

What to expect

During construction, local residents, businesses and road users can expect:

 Changed traffic conditions along various parts of High Street, Ferry Road, Bundall Road and some side streets that adjoin these roads. Motorists are asked to pay attention to local signage.





- Impacts such as construction traffic in the local area, noise and the use of heavy machinery including piling rigs.
- Changes to pedestrian access around the work zones. All changes will be clearly signed to safely direct pedestrians.
- Permanent removal of on-street parking, progressively removed after 10 January 2016.

Changes to kerbs and driveways

Much of the kerb in the work zones along High Street, Ferry Road and Bundall Road will be progressively upgraded and may impact some private driveways.

If your driveway is affected, you will be contacted by a member of the project team before works commence. Access to private driveways will be maintained at all times.

Work hours

The standard work hours are 6am to 6pm Monday to Saturday, however when required, night works will occur from 6pm to 6am Sunday to Thursday. You will be notified in advance of these works.
