

# SITE OFFICE ESTABLISHMENT

## Southport–Burleigh Road Upgrade - Northern section – North Street to Vespa Crescent

December 2015

**From December 2015, BMD Constructions (BMD) will establish site office facilities in the Council owned Baden Powell Park off North Street and Sykes Court, Southport.**

On 18 June 2015 the Queensland Government announced \$104 million to improve Southport–Burleigh Road (High Street, Ferry Road, Bundall Road and Bermuda Street) to cater for current and future traffic volumes on the Gold Coast.

In December 2015, the Department of Transport and Main Roads announced BMD Constructions as the successful tenderer to complete the northern section of the works between North Street, Southport and Vespa Crescent, Bundall. Construction activities are expected to start in January 2016.

The establishment of site office facilities is required to locate the project team close to the works. Site establishment will involve the construction of a hardstand area for temporary offices; the installation of services such as water and sewer; and the removal of vegetation along Sykes Court. Buildings will be moved into place and the area will be securely fenced. Some parking areas along Sykes Court will be removed for site access.

These facilities will be in use from 4 January 2016, Monday to Sunday during day and night works. Residents will notice ongoing movement of construction vehicles and daily office-based activity.

The site office is expected to remain until the completion of construction in 2017. At that time, the park area (including vegetation) will be reinstated.

Every effort will be made by the project team to minimise construction impacts on neighbours and the community.
