## Bridge works update - Bundall bridge

# Southport–Burleigh Road network improvement program Northern section (North Street to Vespa Crescent)

January 2016

Transport and Main Roads is upgrading a 5-kilometre section of Southport-Burleigh Road (High Street, Ferry Road and Bundall Road) between North Street, Southport and Vespa Crescent, Bundall.

As part of this upgrade, TMR's contractor – BMD Constructions – will widen the bridge on Bundall Road (near the Arts Centre Gold Coast).

The bridge will be widened on both sides for the new traffic lanes and a new pedestrian footbridge will be constructed on the eastern side.

#### Site establishment

The project will establish a construction 'satellite' site office in Evandale Park (see below).

This is required to store construction materials and some machinery closer to the area of works and provide facilities for workers.

#### What to expect

Evandale Park area (eastern side):

- Two City of Gold Coast parking spaces will be removed and a gated gravel access track will be constructed through Evandale Park. This track will provide access to the work zone for project vehicles and machinery. Construction traffic will give way to pedestrians at all times.
- Small portable buildings will be located in the site area to provide lunch room and toilet facilities for workers.
- The work area will be securely fenced at all times.
- Ongoing movement of construction vehicles and machinery.

Holden Place (western side):

 The former City of Gold Coast car park area will be fenced for construction use.

The removal of some vegetation will be required on all sides of the bridge for access.

Once the site area is established, work will start to prepare the area for bridge piling. This includes construction of temporary rock platforms on either side of the bridge for access and working platforms in the channel.

An eight metre navigable channel will be maintained in the canal beneath the bridge at all times during these works. Signage will be in place.

#### Work hours

Standard work hours are 6am to 6pm Monday to Saturday. When required, night works will occur from 6pm to 6am Sunday to Thursday.

The site facilities will be in use Monday to Sunday during day and night works. Some oversized and/or heavy loads may also be required to be delivered to site outside of standard work hours when traffic flows are at their lowest.
