Footpath works – Day & night works

Southport–Burleigh Road upgrade Northern section (North Street to Vespa Crescent)

February 2016

Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is upgrading a 5-kilometre section of Southport-Burleigh Road (High Street, Ferry Road and Bundall Road) between North Street, Southport and Vespa Crescent, Bundall.

From 17 February 2016, TMR's contractor – BMD Constructions – will start construction of the off-road shared pedestrian and cycle pathway on the eastern side of Ferry Road between Charlton Street and Yacht Street.

To minimise impacts to the community, work will mainly be undertaken in one block sections. These works will start with the section near Charlton Street.

Each section (block) will take approximately 4 weeks to complete. Please note that weather and site conditions may affect this work schedule.

Footpath works will then start on the western side of Ferry Road.

What to expect

- Construction traffic in your local area.
- Changed traffic conditions including reduced speed limits within the work zone. Please follow signage and obey traffic controller directions.
- Partial lane closures at night.
- The use of heavy plant and machinery including noisy works such as saw cutting and the use of vacuum trucks to excavate around public utilities.
- Changed pedestrian access around the work zones. Changes will be signed to safely direct pedestrians.
- The use of mobile lighting towers at night.

Interruptions to services

Some interruptions to water services (for up to several hours during the day only) may be required for water relocation works. If your water service is affected, you will be contacted by the project team before works start.

No interruption to power is expected during these works.

Pedestrian access

Pedestrian access will be maintained around the work zones for local access only, where possible. Signage will be in place to safely direct pedestrians around the work area.

Driveway changes

Some private driveways will be affected by these works. If your driveway is affected, you will be contacted directly by a member of the project team before work starts.

Work hours

Standard work hours are 6am to 6pm Monday to Saturday.

Where there is insufficient room to maintain two lanes of traffic, footpath works will be completed at night under single lane closures.

Night works will occur from 6pm to 6am Sunday to Thursday.
