

Roadworks – High Street, Ferry Road & Bundall Road

Southport–Burleigh Road upgrade Northern section (North Street to Vespa Crescent)

January 2016

Transport and Main Roads is upgrading a 5-kilometre section of Southport–Burleigh Road (High Street, Ferry Road and Bundall Road) between North Street, Southport and Vespa Crescent, Bundall.

These works will provide long term benefits to the community by increasing the road network capacity and improving traffic flows across the Gold Coast.

About the project

Key features of the project include:

- creation of a third traffic lane in both directions
- pavement resurfacing and median works
- intersection upgrades
- widening of two bridges – Benowa Canal Bridge and Korong Channel Bridge
- service relocation works.

To minimise the impact to the community, the project will be delivered in one kilometre zones.

Zone	Section	Timeframe
1	North Street to Lawson Street	Jan 2016 – mid-2016
2	Lawson Street to Charlton Street	Mid-2016 – late 2016
3	Charlton Street to Yacht Street	Jan 2016 – mid 2016
4	Yacht Street to Thomas Drive	Mid-2016 – late-2016
5	Thomas Drive to Vespa Crescent	Jan 2016 – mid-2016

Works will generally start on the eastern side of the road, and once complete, progress to the western side then median works.

The final stage of activities will include road resurfacing across all zones from late-2016 to early-2017.

Please note that weather, contractor and site conditions may affect this work schedule.

Parking removal & driveway changes

To create a third traffic lane in each direction, on-street parking is progressively being removed. These changes are permanent.

Some private driveways will be affected by these works. If your driveway is affected, you will be contacted directly by a member of the project team before work starts.
