Night works

Southport–Burleigh Road Upgrade Northern section (North Street to Vespa Crescent)

Transport and Main Roads is upgrading a 5-kilometre section of Southport–Burleigh Road (High Street, Ferry Road and Bundall Road) between North Street, Southport and Vespa Crescent, Bundall.

A key feature of the project is the creation of a third traffic lane in each direction by removing the on-street parking.

The project will provide long term benefits to the community by increasing the road network capacity, improving traffic flows and easing congestion across the Gold Coast.

Night works

To keep traffic moving during construction, TMR's contractor – BMD Constructions – will maintain two lanes of traffic in both directions during daytime works.

Due to the nature of the work and the high traffic volumes on Southport–Burleigh Road, some work can only be completed at night, when traffic flows are at their lowest, including:

- intersection works
- some footpath and driveway upgrades
- works that require lane closures
- over-sized or heavy deliveries to the work zones.

What to expect

• Changed traffic conditions including lane closures and reduced speed limits around the works for the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers.

Construction vehicles on local roads.

 At various times local residents may experience short-term impacts such as changed lighting, noise and vibration from construction activities, such as:

- vacuum trucks to safely excavate around underground services
- o saw cutting to cut through concrete
- trucks removing concrete and other redundant materials from the work zones
- chainsaws for the trimming and/or removal of vegetation along the alignment
- o trucks and machinery laying asphalt.

The project team has strategies in place to minimise impacts where possible, however your patience and understanding is appreciated.

Work hours

Night works will occur from January 2016 to January 2017 on High Street, Ferry Road and Bundall Road (between High Street and Vespa Crescent) Sunday to Thursday from 6pm to 6am, when required.
