Removal of on-street parking

Southport–Burleigh Road network improvement project Southern section (Fremar Street to Rudd Street)

The Department of Transport and Main Roads is carrying out works to upgrade Southport–Burleigh Road (Bermuda Street), Broadbeach Waters.

Work will soon begin to create a third traffic lane in both directions of Bermuda Street.

As part of these works, on-street parking will be permanently removed on both sides of Bermuda Street, between Fremar Street and Rudd Street.

A continuous yellow 'No Stopping' line will be marked which prohibits motorists from parking in the lane.

Once linemarking is complete, on-street parking between Fremar Street and Rudd Street will constitute a parking infringement and will attract penalties.

Timeframes

Linemarking on Bermuda Street is scheduled for:

- **Wednesday 10 February 2016
between 7pm and 6am.**

Residents are advised to please ensure all vehicles are removed from the kerbside prior to work commencing.

For safety and traffic management reasons, this work must be undertaken at night when traffic volumes are lower.

It is important to note that wet weather, contractor and site conditions may change this work schedule.

What to expect

During these works, the following traffic conditions can be expected:

- the kerbside lane in both directions of Bermuda Street will be closed while linemarking is completed
- speed will be reduced to 40km/h through the work zone
- signage will advise pedestrians of any changed access to footpaths and pathways.

Following the completion of these works, on-street parking on both sides of Bermuda Street will be permanently removed.
