

REMOVAL OF PARKING

Southport–Burleigh Road Upgrade - Northern section – North Street to Vespa Crescent

January 2016

BMD Constructions has started work to upgrade a 5-kilometre section of Southport–Burleigh Road (High Street, Ferry Road and Bundall Road).

A key feature of this project is the creation of a third traffic lane in each direction by removing the on-street parking.

To facilitate this, from 10 January 2016, the on-street parking along High Street, Ferry Road and Bundall Road will be progressively and permanently removed.

What to expect:

- Line marking will be changed to indicate the permanent removal of on-street parking
- City of Gold Coast will remove parking pay stations, road sensors and signage.

As a part of these works, the 12 City of Gold Coast owned car parks near Holden Place, Bundall will also be removed to enable access for the bridge upgrade works in that area and provide space for construction site facilities.
