

SITE OFFICE ESTABLISHMENT

Southport–Burleigh Road Upgrade - Northern section – North Street to Vespa Crescent

January 2016

BMD Constructions has started work to upgrade a 5-kilometre section of Southport–Burleigh Road (High Street, Ferry Road and Bundall Road). In mid-January 2016, the project will establish a construction ‘satellite’ site office on vacant land next to the Energex substation near the corner of Queen Street and Ferry Road, Southport.

This ‘satellite’ site office is required to store construction materials and some machinery closer to the area of works and provide facilities for workers. As such, this area may be accessed whenever project personnel are working in the area.

What to expect:

- A portable lunch room, toilet facilities and storage containers will be moved into place
- The area will be securely fenced at all times
- Some removal of vegetation may be required
- Ongoing movement of construction vehicles and machinery.

Work hours:

The project’s standard work hours are 6am to 6pm Monday to Saturday, however when required, night works will occur from 6pm to 6am Sunday to Thursday. This ‘satellite’ site office will be in use Monday to Sunday during day and night works.

Every effort will be made by the project team to minimise construction impacts on neighbours and the community.
