Southport-Burleigh Road network improvement program Southern section (Fremar Street to Rudd Street)

From early February 2016, Georgiou on behalf of the Department of Transport and Main Roads will be carrying out works to upgrade Southport–Burleigh Road (Bermuda Street), between Fremar Street and Rudd Street, Broadbeach Waters.

The upgrade will provide long-term benefits to the community by increasing the road network capacity and improving the traffic flow across the Gold Coast.

Construction is expected to be completed by mid 2016. Please note that weather, contractor and site conditions may affect this work schedule.

About the project

Key features of the upgrade include:

- · creation of a third traffic lane in both directions
- · pavement resurfacing and median works
- upgrades to the Rudd Street and Fremar Street intersections
- service protection works and relocations
- · drainage works
- · revised linemarking and signage.

What to expect

- Changed traffic conditions including reduced speed limits and detours within the works zone. Please follow signage and obey traffic controller directions.
- Construction activities may cause increased noise, dust, light and vibration around the work site. Impacts will be monitored and minimised where possible.
- Increased congestion and traffic on Southport– Burleigh Road and surrounding routes for the duration of works.
- Changes to pedestrian access around the work zone.
 Changes will be signed to safely direct pedestrians.
- Permanent removal of on-street parking. Parking will be removed as major construction starts.
- Work will generally take place between the hours of 6am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday.
- For safety reasons, some work must be carried out at night when traffic volumes are low. Nearby residents will be notified in advance of night works.



 The contractor Georgiou is responsible to ensure that access to private driveways is maintained at all times.

Changes to kerb and driveways

Some private driveways will be altered as part of these works.

If your driveway is affected, you will be contacted directly by a member of the project team before work commences.
