

Vegetation trimming and removal - day and night works

Southport–Burleigh Road Upgrade Northern section (North Street to Vespa Crescent)

February 2016

Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is upgrading a 5-kilometre section of Southport–Burleigh Road (High Street, Ferry Road and Bundall Road).

During February 2016, TMR's contractor – BMD Constructions – will be trimming and/or removing vegetation such as trees and shrubs along the project alignment, in preparation for construction.

Most of this vegetation removal is required to access the work area or due to tree canopies over-hanging in the project footprint.

To keep the traffic moving during construction, two lanes of traffic will be maintained in both directions between 6am and 6pm.

Works that require lane closures will be completed at night when traffic flows are at their lowest.

What to expect:

- Changed traffic conditions including lane closures and reduced speed limits where the vegetation to be trimmed or removed is close to the road.
- Noise during the day and at night from the use of heavy machinery including chainsaws and wood chippers.
- The use of elevated work platforms.
- Lighting towers to light the work zones at night.
- Construction traffic in the area.

In some cases, vegetation to be trimmed or removed may be in or over-hanging private properties. If access is required to your property, you will be contacted by the project team before the works occur.

Work hours

Standard daytime work hours are 6am to 6pm Monday to Saturday. Night works will occur Sunday to Thursday from 6pm to 6am.

Most required tree trimming and removal along the project alignment is expected to be complete by late February 2016.
