Car Park Removal on Veloway 1 Stage E

Birdwood Road, Holland Park West to Gaza Road, Tarragindi

Dear Resident

Veloway 1 Stage E – Temporary closure on street car parking and changed access for pedestrians

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) would like to advise that **on street car parks** and footpath on the eastern side of Bapaume Road will be unavailable from October 2018 for up to 24 months to allow for the construction of the Veloway 1 (V1) Stage E. Signage will be provided to direct pedestrians to use the footpath on the opposite side of Bapaume Road. This provides a safe working space for construction activities and preventsprivately owned vehicles from potential damage during construction (please see map on reverse side).

Upgrading V1 will provide better connectivity to the local cycle networks. The improvements made to V1 aim to encourage active healthy lifestyles and to encourage more people to take up this greener mode of transport. This is the largest construction stage of V1 undertaken by TMR, and once complete will link with the other four existing V1 stages to provide a dedicated cycleway from Gateway Motorway off-ramp at Eight Mile Plains to Lower River Terrace in South Brisbane, where it connects to Brisbane City Council's Kangaroo Point Bikeway.

Timing:

• On street car parks and footpath on the eastern side of Bapaume Road will be temporarily unavailable from October 2018 for up to 24 months.

Work will include:

- Using the car parking spaces for construction related duties (constructing new retaining walls and structures, craning materials, delivering materials to site)
- Possible disturbance to road surface (removing bitumen)

Expected impacts:

- Temporary closure of on street car parking
- Temporary diversion for pedestrians


