

# Piling Notification – Veloway 1 Stage E

Dear Resident

## Veloway 1 Stage E – Piling Works

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) would like to advise piling works for the Veloway 1 Stage E project will be commencing.

### About the project

Veloway 1 (V1) Stage E will provide a dedicated cycleway from Birdwood Road, Holland Park West, to the existing Veloway facilities at Gaza Road, Tarragindi.

This project will include three dedicated cycle bridges over Marshall Road, Sterculia Avenue and Bapaume Road near Gaza Road. Removing multiple road crossings will provide a safer route for people to cycle.

There will be new access points to the cycleway constructed at Bapaume Road, opposite Peronne Road, as well as ramp connections from Gaza Road and the south side of Birdwood Road.

### Project Works:

Work will include delivery of piling materials on semi-trailers, concrete deliveries, drilling and piling and earthworks (trucks and excavators removing fill).

TMR will make every effort to minimize impacts and appreciates your patience while these works are carried out.

### Timing:

- Piling works will commence from **week commencing 21 January 2019 and expect to complete mid-2019**, weather and construction conditions permitting.
- Where possible, piling will be undertaken during the day in areas where it is safe to do so with minimal impacts to the road network. The Birdwood Road basin in the area between Birdwood Road and Marshall Road will be installed as day works. Piling works will primarily be undertaken at night to ensure the safety of the work crew and road users and to minimise the impact to the road network.
- Day works will take place from **7 am until 5 pm, Monday to Saturday**.
- Night works will take place from **7 pm until 5 am, Sunday to Thursday**.
- Some Friday night works may also be required to meet construction timeframes.

### Expected impacts:

- Nearby residents/businesses may experience short term impacts, including noise, dust, vibration, lighting, loss of parking from construction equipment and activities onsite.
- Changed traffic conditions will include reduced speed limits, lane or shoulder closures and minor delays.
- Motorists should expect changed conditions, including speed limit restrictions, temporary loss of parking spaces, partial lane closures and other traffic control measures throughout the work site.

TMR will distribute notifications to nearby residents and businesses before work begins. This notification will include information on the work and the contact details for the Project Team.
