Road Toll for Easter 2010

In this report the characteristics of road fatalities within Queensland for the Easter long weekend reporting period during 2010 are analysed and compared with the same reporting period for 2005 to 2009.

There were two people killed in road crashes within Queensland during the 2010 Easter long weekend reporting period (Thursday 1st April to Monday 5th April). This is three fatalities (or 60.0%) fewer then the 2009 Easter long weekend reporting period and two fatalities (or 45.5%) fewer than the 2005 to 2009 Easter long weekend reporting period average.

One fatality was a bicyclist and one fatality was a driver.

Two fatalities were male.

One fatality occurred along a State controlled road and one fatality occurred along a locally controlled road.

Two fatalities were involved in multi-vehicle type crashes.

One fatality occurred within the Central Police Region and one fatality occurred within the Southern Police Region.

One fatality occurred on Easter Saturday and one fatality occurred on Easter Sunday.
