Snapshot – North Coast Region

Our region

An area of about 10,539km², or 0.5 per cent of Queensland.

Estimated residential population of around 879,985 people, 17 per cent of Queensland's total population.

Responsible for 129km of National Land Transport Network, 1240km of state-controlled roads, 127km Nation Rail Network.

Our key challenges



People – Continued difficulty in attracting and retaining suitable skilled and experienced contractors and project managers.



Materials – Peaks in demand affect supply and cost of materials.

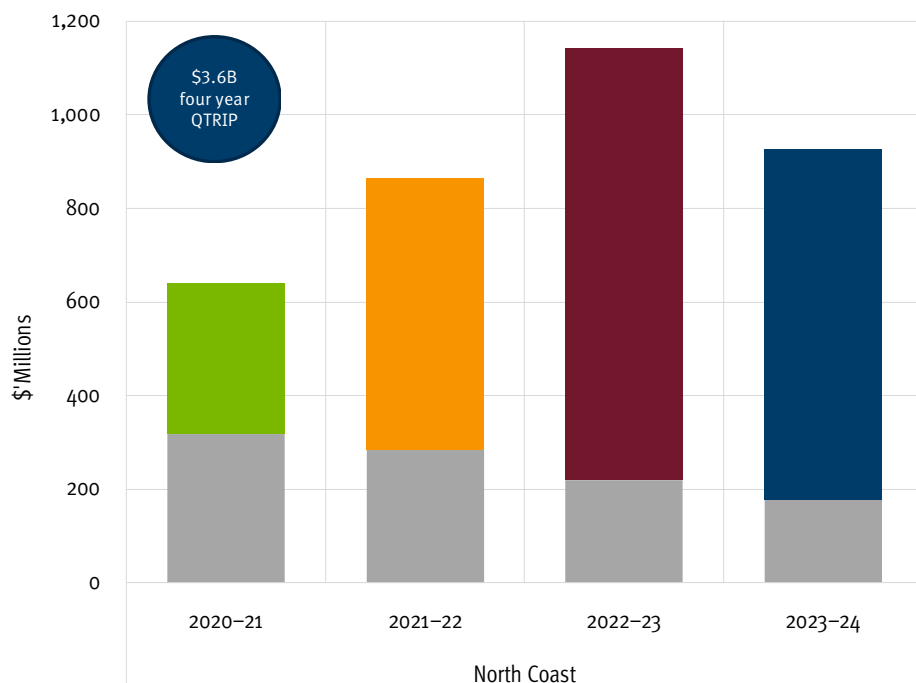


Weather – Unseasonal/severe/prolonged wet seasons affecting the delivery of the program.

Queensland Transport and Roads Investment Program (QTRIP) 2020–21 to 2023–24 budget



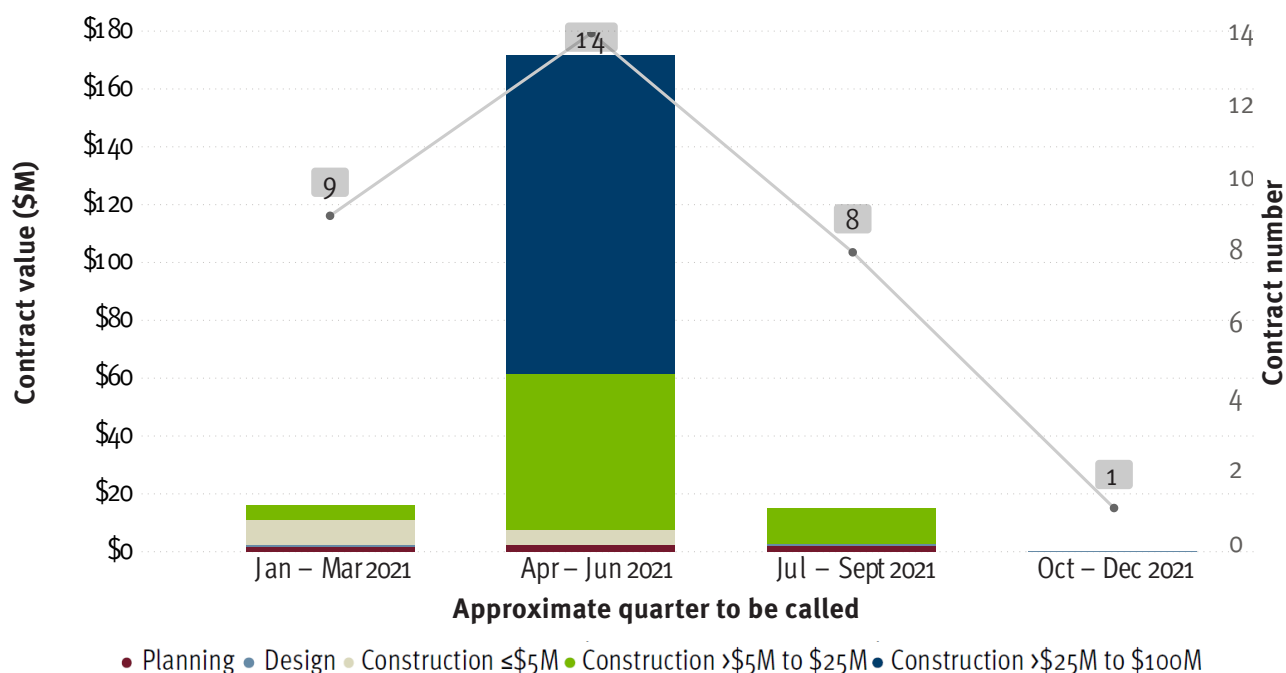
