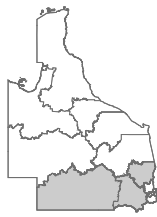


Queensland Transport and Roads Investment Program 2020–21 to 2023–24

Snapshot – Southern Queensland Region



Our region

An area of about 447,292km², extending north to Kalpowar, east to Hervey Bay, south to Goondiwindi on the New South Wales border and west to the South Australian border.

Estimated residential population around 12 per cent of Queensland's total population.

Responsible for 10,076km of state-controlled roads and about 1376km of National Land Transport Network.

Our key challenges



People – High demand of specialised skills in Delivery and Operations, Program Planning, Materials Lab and Survey Resources.



Materials – Limited availability of prequalified gravel pits.



Weather – Drought, accessible water resources are limited, particularly in southern areas.

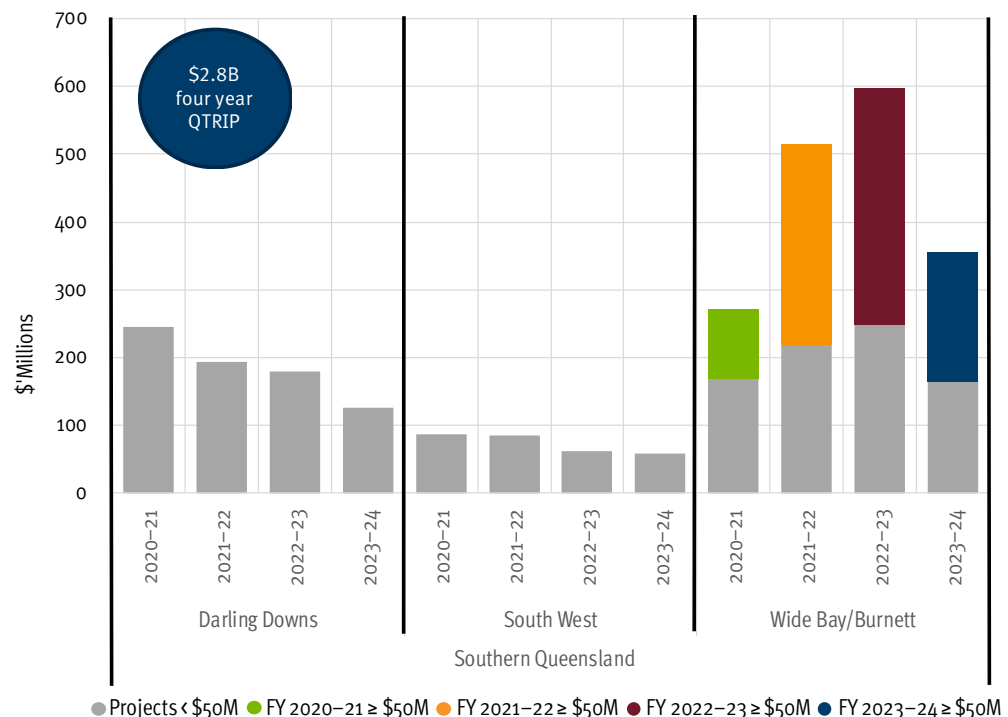


Ground conditions – Black soil commonly found – cracks open when dry and swells during wetting.



Public Utility Plant – Services found during construction phase not identified in design.

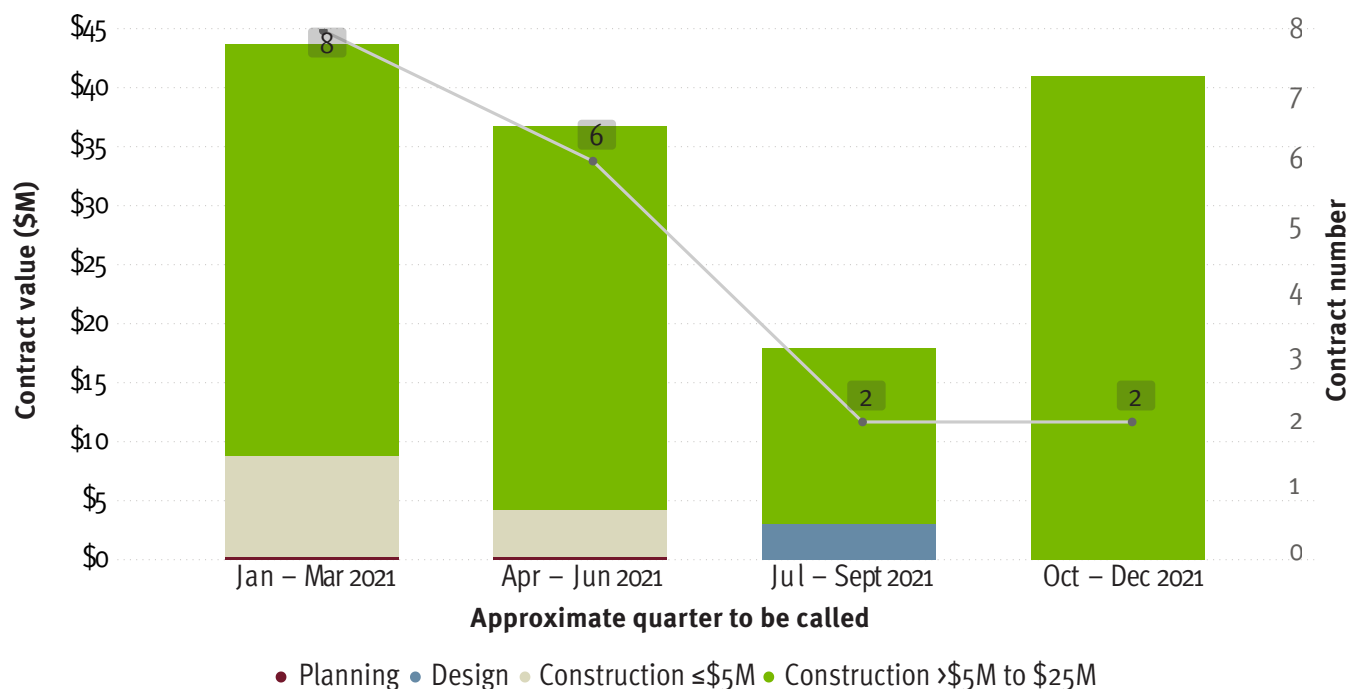
