Implementation of Version 2.1 of the National Heavy Vehicle Inspection Manual

April 2016

Purpose

The purpose of this Information Sheet is to advise Approved Persons (APs) of the adoption of the National Heavy Vehicle Inspection Manual (NHVIM) Version 2.1 into the Queensland heavy vehicle inspection scheme from **1 July 2016**.

The NHVIM Version 2.1 is the foundation for a consistent national approach to heavy vehicle inspections and the improvement of safety across the Australian heavy vehicle industry through the National Heavy Vehicle Roadworthiness Program.

Introduction

In February 2014, the National Heavy Vehicle Regulator (NHVR) introduced a national consolidated inspection manual, the NHVIM Version 1.

As part of the National Heavy Vehicle Roadworthiness Program, the NHVR completed a review of the NHVIM Version 1. The review of the manual focused on ensuring:

1. the technical content reflected the *Heavy Vehicle (Vehicle Standards) National Regulation* and relevant ADRs
2. the manual was user-friendly, with updated tables, graphics and images.

The NHVR published the updated NHVIM Version 2.1 on 15 December 2015.

All participating state and territory transport authorities have agreed to adopt the NHVIM Version 2.1 into their inspection regimes by 1 July 2016.

The implementation of NHVIM Version 2.1 is not expected to have any impact on APs, however the Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) and the NHVR are providing this information sheet to ensure APs are kept up-to-date of the changes made.

Implementation

In partnership with the NHVR, TMR will adopt the NHVIM Version 2.1 as the inspection standard used by approved examiners at Approved Inspection Stations (AIS) for heavy vehicle inspections from 1 July 2016.

From this date, approved examiners will be required to use the NHVIM Version 2.1 when conducting heavy vehicle inspections, replacing the former NHVIM Version 1.

The NHVIM Version 2.1 is available on the NHVR's website at www.nhvr.gov.au/nhvim and can be downloaded as a complete document or as individual sections, including separate inspection checklists for both heavy vehicles and trailers.

Differences between NHVIM Version 2.1 and Version 1

The NHVIM Version 2.1 uses a similar layout and structure as the previous version and will be very familiar to approved examiners.

The main differences between the manuals are minor technical changes that ensure the reasons for rejection are clear and reflect advances in vehicle design and construction. In addition, most of the appendices have been incorporated directly into the relevant sections and all graphics have been redrawn to ensure ease-of-use.

In particular, approved examiners will now be required to inspect motorhomes, caravans and campervans as outlined in Section 15 of the manual. The criteria in Section 15 of the manual have not been previously assessed by approved examiners in Queensland.

NHVIM Version 2.1 also includes Vehicle Dimensions (Section 16). In Queensland, approved examiners are not required to undertake a dimension inspection. These inspections will continue to be performed by Heavy Vehicle Registration Assessment Scheme (HVRAS) accredited persons or at TMR Customer Service Centres (CSCs) during pre-registration inspections.
