Reassessment of Practical Assessment

Purpose

This BoatSafe Information Bulletin outlines the requirements for the reassessment of students who are not yet competent within their practical assessment.

Requirements

Section 14.7 of the BoatSafe Business Rules stipulates that students are entitled to one practical assessment attempt per day.

Where a student has been deemed not yet competent, the BTP authority holder must retain the completed Practical Assessment Statement on the student file. Upon return of the student, the BTP authority holder must utilise a new copy of the relevant Practical Assessment Statement. The student may undertake only the activities deemed as not yet competent, under the same assessment conditions as per a full assessment. The BTP authority holder may choose to reassess the student on all competencies.

If the student is deemed competent within these activities, the BTP authority holder must retain all copies of the completed Practical Assessment Statement on the student file to evidence that a competent outcome in the stipulated practical activities has been achieved.

It should be noted that the BTP authority holder must provide retraining on the practical activities deemed not yet competent prior to the student undertaking the practical assessment.

The student has three (3) months from the initial practical assessment to return and be reassessed on only those activities deemed not yet competent. If a student returns outside of this timeframe, a full course resit is required.
