





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# Bribie Island bridge planning

January 2024

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is planning for a new bridge to Bribie Island and for the future of the existing bridge.

The business case for a new bridge is looking to improve the safety and reliability of the connection between Bribie Island and the mainland.

A new bridge is part of the Queensland Government's strategy for progressive upgrades to provide four lanes along the length of Caboolture-Bribie Island Road.

The proposed concept design is for a new bridge that provides two eastbound traffic lanes and a dedicated active transport path for bike riders, pedestrians and mobility devices. The active transport path on the northern side will enable uninterrupted views of the iconic Glass House Mountains.

The existing bridge can continue carrying traffic for the foreseeable future. The concept design proposes to fully utilise the existing bridge as a traffic asset by using it for two westbound lanes.

The business case investigations found this is the most feasible option to deliver a safer, reliable, sustainable network for current and future transport needs.

# **Business case investigations**

The business case phase is important because it confirms the project need, assesses how an upgrade could be designed and constructed and develops cost estimates to support funding requests.

A detailed assessment found the existing bridge can continue to be used for traffic with continuation of its maintenance program.

Peak period travel delays were found to be primarily experienced at the Benabrow Avenue and Sylvan Beach Esplanade intersections rather than on the bridge. However, the narrow bridge with one lane in each direction contributes to safety issues and travel delays when vehicles cannot pass during incidents such as crashes or breakdowns.

Reported incidents have an average duration of two hours. Unreported incidents also result in delays. While crashes are not common, they generally require medical treatment.

The population and traffic volume have grown significantly since the existing bridge was built in 1963. While the area continues to be popular with visitors, Bribie Island's population and traffic volume are expected to experience moderate growth in the future.

The need for reliable access, improved safety and providing equitable access for pedestrians, bike riders and mobility devices are the greatest drivers for a new bridge rather than the condition of the existing bridge, peak period congestion or traffic volume growth.

The concept design confirms the new bridge's northern location, next to the existing bridge, is the most viable location to limit environmental impacts, connect communities and maximise use of existing state-owned properties.

## Community feedback so far

Thank you to everyone who participated in consultation held in early 2023. TMR received more than 3600 responses.

Consultation found that improved access, safety, and congestion were extremely important to the community as well as emergency service access. Respondents also highlighted the importance of reliable access to family, work, education, recreation, and community services with personal and commercial impacts noted. The narrow bike and pedestrian path was a key concern.

While preferences varied on the number of lanes, feedback generally supported a new bridge with the ability to move traffic between lanes during an incident, and active transport improvements for pedestrians, bike riders and mobility devices.

Improvements to roads either side of the bridge were also requested.

Feedback expressed a desire to keep the existing bridge, noting its iconic status and heritage character. There were some requests for fishing, markets, cafes and landscaping on the existing bridge.

The community requested a sustainable, value-for-money solution that considers the environment and future transport needs.

Supporters for a new bridge referred to benefits such as improved traffic flow, connection, health, safety, lifestyle, tourism and economic growth.

Opponents to a new bridge were generally concerned a new bridge would increase traffic and visitors, impacting the environment and lifestyle.

The artist's impression to the left is of the new bridge which is estimated to be up to 4m higher than the existing bridge at its highest point (near mid-channel). The detailed design phase will consider this further with the aim of reducing the bridge height if possible. The increased height accommodates additional structure depth, facilitates drainage and maintains clearance for the navigation channel with consideration for expected sea level rise due to climate change. The pier format also maintains the navigation channel beneath the bridges. Pelican perches will overhang the water. For the safety of road and active transport users, and marine craft, fishing will not be permitted from either bridge. Source: TMR.



# Sustainable, flexible concept design

The concept design provides a long-term solution for a safer, more reliable transport network.

Crash risk and severity are reduced because the traffic on each bridge is travelling in the same direction, with additional lanes or shoulders available to help avoid or pass incidents. Crossing points on the roads approaching the bridges enable traffic to transfer between bridges if required when incidents or maintenance works occur.

The concept design is a sustainable, flexible, and cost-effective solution.

Fully utilising the existing bridge as a long-term operational traffic bridge is a sustainable approach to managing the transport network. This reduces the width, cost and impact associated with constructing a new bridge.

This is in comparison to a new four-lane bridge, with active transport on the existing bridge, which provides similar safety and reliability improvements, but at a higher cost.

Strategic cost estimates indicate a new four-lane bridge could cost up to 20 per cent more with a greater environmental footprint due to the wider deck and significant retrofitting of the existing bridge to align with current active transport and accessibility standards. Cost assessment is continuing as technical development of the concept design progresses.

The new bridge has wider lanes and shoulders and can provide a safer and reliable standalone connection for two-way traffic and active transport if the existing bridge is closed due to an incident, emergency or maintenance.

The concept design aligns with the future vision of four lanes on Caboolture-Bribie island Road and provides a flexible and cost-effective approach to investment by delaying the need to provide a wider bridge until the existing bridge has reached its service life. The new bridge can be further widened at that time to provide four traffic lanes and an active transport path.

Timeframes for design and construction are not currently known. Funding will be considered in the future against other transport infrastructure priorities across the state.

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# Frequently asked questions

## Will Benabrow Avenue be upgraded?

Benabrow Avenue is the responsibility of City of Moreton Bay. The development of a bridge concept design will provide certainty to help council to consider the local road network and prepare for the future development of a new bridge.

# Will Caboolture-Bribie Island Road be duplicated before the new bridge is built?

The concept design includes four lanes between Bestmann Road East and Benabrow Avenue. The Queensland Government has a strategy for progressive upgrades to provide four lanes along the length of Caboolture-Bribie Island Road. Upgrades are undertaken as funding becomes available and are generally sequenced to progress from west to east.

# Was active transport on the existing bridge considered?

Yes, the option of active transport on the existing bridge alongside a new four-lane traffic bridge was considered. This option would cost more and involve additional environmental and community impacts due to the need for a wider bridge to support four lanes.

Also, significant retrofitting of the existing bridge to align with current active transport and accessibility standards would be required. The existing bridge can continue to be fully utilised as a traffic bridge. This is a sustainable solution that provides for long-term transport needs.

# Why not build a bridge between Toorbul/ Donnybrook and Banksia Beach/White Patch?

This would not address the safety, reliability and active transport issues for the existing bridge and would involve impacts on other roads, communities (including land impacts) and marine areas. The location next to the existing bridge provides the best connection to the supporting road network, utilises state owned properties, and links existing development and community facilities.

# What happens if the existing bridge is decommissioned?

The existing bridge can be used for the foreseeable future as a long-term traffic bridge. TMR will continue to monitor the condition of the existing bridge and ensure appropriate maintenance works are completed. The proposed concept design can be widened to provide additional lanes in the future and TMR will plan for this before decommissioning of the existing bridge is required.



# Caboolture-Bribie Island Road, Bribie Island bridge, planning

The department is developing a business case for the construction of a new bridge to Bribie Island.

The existing Bribie Island bridge was constructed in 1963 and consists of 2 traffic lanes and a narrow pedestrian pathway. The proposal for a new bridge forms part of the Queensland Government's broader strategy to upgrade the Caboolture-Bribie Island Road to a 4-lane standard.

The business case draws on previous studies and incorporates insights from technical investigations and community consultations. This has led to the proposal of a concept design for a new bridge.

The new bridge will feature 2 eastbound traffic lanes and a dedicated active transport path for bicycle riders, pedestrians and users of mobility devices. The active transport path on the northern side of the bridge will offer uninterrupted views of the iconic Glass House Mountains.

The existing bridge can sustain traffic for the foreseeable future. The concept design proposes to fully utilise the existing bridge as a traffic asset by using it for 2 westbound traffic lanes.

Also, part of the plan is to widen the Caboolture-Bribie Island Road to 4 lanes between Bestmann Road East and Benabrow Avenue, as well as realigning the Sylvan Beach Esplanade intersection.

The concept design optimises cost, sustainability, and flexibility. It uses the existing bridge as a long-term operational traffic asset and is a sustainable approach to managing the transport network. This reduces the width, cost and impact associated with constructing a new bridge.

The concept design aligns with the future vision of 4 lanes on Caboolture-Bribie Island Road. By delaying the need to provide a wider bridge until the existing bridge has reached its service life, it provides a flexible and cost-effective approach to investment.



## Report released on Bribie Island bridge concept design consultation

- Mostly positive feedback received for the proposed concept design
- Preliminary cost estimate identifies \$700 million for detailed design and construction
- Business case completion expected in early 2025

Comments received during consultation on the concept design for a new bridge to Bribie Island were mostly positive.

The concept design proposes a new bridge that provides two easibound lanes and an active transport path, with the existing bridge providing two westbound lanes.

Two phases of community consultation have been held during business case investigations for a new bridge, with over 4000 comments received in total. The first phase helped to inform development of the proposed concept design.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) received around 600 responses during the second phase of consultation held between 11 January and 11 March 2024.

Most feedback was positive with some negative, neutral and mixed responses.

Supportive comments generally referred to the concept design's ability to improve travel reliability and safety, particularly for emergency services, with subsequent lifestyle improvements.

There was support for specific features including additional traffic lanes, the ability to switch traffic between bridges if required and modifications to Sylvan Beach Esplanade intersection.

Some comments also referred to the cost effectiveness and flexibility of retaining the existing bridge to provide westbound traffic larges and the ability to widen the new bridge in the future.

Comments on the proposed facilities for pedestrians, bike riders and mobility device users were generally positive. While there was general support for the concept design's active transport path, there were also some requests for separation between pedestrians and bike riders, seating and shade. This will be considered as the project progresses.

Negative comments generally referred to preferences for an alternative design, particularly a new four-lane bridge with active transport on the existing bridge. Some respondents preferred a new bridge be built further north. Some suggested a lane for active transport, public transport or emergency services only, and some requested no upgrade at all.

TMR has achieved significant milestones as part of planning for a new bridge to Bribie Island including completion of technical investigations, options analysis and community consultation.

The business case has involved significant technical investigations on the condition of the existing bridge and geotechnical assessment of the area where a new bridge could be built.

The concept design has progressed sufficiently to develop a preliminary cost estimate of \$700 million to develop a detailed design and construct a new bridge. 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Some comments also referred to the cost effectiveness and flexibility of retaining the existing bridge to provide westbound traffic larges and the ability to widen the new bridge in the future.

Comments on the proposed facilities for pedestrians, bike riders and mobility device users were generally positive. While there was general support for the concept design's active transport path, there were also some requests for separation between pedestrians and bike riders, seating and shade. This will be considered as the project progresses.

Negative comments generally referred to preferences for an alternative design, particularly a new four-lane bridge with active transport on the existing bridge. 

The Bribie Island bridge project has completed significant planning and investigations to determine a concept design and preliminary cost, while the Bli Bli Bridge upgrade is still in the options analysis planning phase.

Ninderry MP Dan Purdie has today challenged the Premier to commit to replacing the historic Bli Bli bridge on the Sunshine Coast, following the announcement of a \$700million bridge duplication project in a marginal seat near Brisbane.

The iconic Bli Bli bridge on the David Low Way was purpose built in 1959 to service cane trains from the former Nambour sugar mill.

Estimated to now carry up to 15,000 vehicles a day, the narrow two-lane bridge has been the subject of extensive engineering and structural investigations due to safety concerns in recent years, with a 20-tonne load limit in place since 2019.

"Bli Bli is one of the fastest growing suburbs on the coast and the bridge is no longer fit for purpose. Transport and Main Roads (TMR) has done extensive consultation identifying the need to replace it, but instead of fixing it, the government has instead chosen the cheaper \$1.6million band-aid solution," Mr Purdie said.

"This is just another example of the State Labor government taking the residents of the Sunshine Coast for granted, failing to invest in the infrastructure needed to support our region's growth.


