TMR working to assess and reopen NQ roads as soon as possible

The Department of Transport and Main Roads acknowledges the challenges faced by residents and travellers in Northern Queensland and we are working to assess and reopen roads as soon as it is possible and safe to do so.

We are monitoring the Bruce Highway situation closely.

After floodwaters recede, it's crucial that we conduct thorough inspections of the roads and associated infrastructure including bridges.

Once the water level has subsided to a safe level, our inspection team and engineers will work on getting the road open as quickly and as safely as we can.

Safety is our top priority, not only for motorists but for our inspection crews as well. Assessments will take place only when it is deemed safe for our crews to access and evaluate the affected areas.
