Safer speeds at Brendale

The speed limit on a section of South Pine Road at Brendale will be reduced to improve road-user safety.

Transport and Main Roads North Coast Regional Director Scott Whitaker said the limit would be reduced from 80km/h to 70km/h on the stretch, between Eatons Crossing Road and Bradford Court, this month (July).

Mr Whitaker said the reduction followed a review by the Speed Management Committee which includes representatives from the Queensland Police Service, Moreton Bay Regional Council and Transport and Main Roads (TMR).

“The review process considers a range of factors such as road function, roadside environment, road construction standards, prevailing traffic speeds and crash history,” Mr Whitaker said.

“In consideration of these factors, the committee has endorsed TMR's recommendation to permanently reduce the speed limit from 80km/h to 70km/h.

“I urge all motorists to observe the new speed limit signs and to always drive to conditions.”

The new limit will be in force in the week of 12 July.
