Goodwood Road safety improvements to begin construction soon

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is ready to start construction and improve safety at key intersections along Goodwood Road in Bundaberg in the coming weeks.

With final designs now complete, the new signalised intersections at Goodwood Road (also known locally as Barolin Street) and McCarthy Road and Thabeban Street are set to enhance safety for motorists.

The final designs include the installation of traffic signals, dedicated bike lanes and pedestrian crossings at these intersections.

As part of the design process, TMR presented an option to the community that involved closing the Goodwood Road and Dunn Road intersection entirely. However, in response to feedback from local residents, the design now includes a provision allowing vehicles to make a left turn into Dunn Road from Goodwood Road. No other movements at this intersection will be available.

In addition to the upgrades, safety improvements will also occur at the Goodwood Road and Coonarr Road intersection in Kinkuna.

Proposed enhancements include a realignment of the Thieles Road intersection at Coonarr Road, and extra warning signs have already been installed at the Goodwood Road and Coonarr Road intersection.

Construction is expected to commence in the coming weeks, weather and other conditions permitting.

TMR remains committed to improving road safety and ensuring a safer travel experience for all road users.
