Intersection upgrade at Mount Lindesay Highway and Kooralbyn Road now complete

- Safety improvements at the Mount Lindesay Highway and Kooralbyn Road intersection are now complete
- New street lights installed to improve night safety
- Reduced speed limits are now in place along the upgraded intersection [key takeout points]

The Australian and Queensland governments have completed safety improvements in Kooralbyn, providing residents and visitors a safer drive along Mount Lindesay Highway.

The upgrades include dedicated right-turn and left-turn lanes from Mount Lindesay Highway onto Kooralbyn Road, as well as a reduced speed limit on Mount Lindesay Highway through the intersection from 100km/h to 80km/h, and through the school zone on school days from 80km/h to 60km/h.

Seven new street lights have been installed to improve night safety with the road widened and additional drainage works also undertaken.

The upgrades are part of a \$2.5 million Queensland Transport Road Investment Program budget, 50/50 jointly funded by the Australian and Queensland Governments under the Road Safety Program.

The works, which began in June 2025, have finished on schedule. The project used 1625 cubic metres of rock to widen the road and laid 560m of asphalt.

Safer intersections mean fewer crashes and more confidence for drivers, whether they are locals or visitors passing through. These safety upgrades will benefit all drivers.

Transport and Main Roads' South Coast Regional Director Andrew Wheeler said the safety improvements would provide a safer route for the local community.

“This section of Mount Lindesay Highway has a history of road crashes and these improvements will increase safety for all road users travelling through the intersection, particularly those turning onto Kooralbyn Road,” Mr Wheeler said.

“The upgrades will make turning movements safer and smoother for all road users who travel within the Scenic Rim area.”
