

Local road named in honour of Olympic Gold Medallist Logan Martin

- A new local road in Springwood has been named after Australian Olympian and Logan local, Logan Martin.
- Logan Martin Court provides bicycle riders access to Veloway 1 at Springwood.
- The new road was constructed as part of the Pacific Motorway (M1): Eight Mile Plains to Daisy Hill Upgrade.

Australian BMX Olympic Gold Medallist, Logan Martin OAM, has had a newly constructed local service road in the City of Logan named in his honour.

Constructed as part of the Department of Transport and Main Road's (TMR) Pacific Motorway (M1): Eight Mile Plains to Daisy Hill Upgrade and alongside the Veloway 1 (V1) extension, Logan Martin Court now sits proudly in Springwood, adjacent to the V1 entry.

The City of Logan road name was inspired by Martin's gold medal win at the inaugural BMX freestyle event at the Tokyo Summer Olympics in 2021, the road's proximity to the new V1 bicycle extension, and his long association with the Logan community.

The Pacific Motorway (M1): Eight Mile Plains to Daisy Hill Upgrade is expected to be completed in mid-2025. The \$750 million project was jointly funded by the Australian Government contributing \$510 million and the Queensland Government contributing \$240 million.

Motorists and locals are already benefitting from the extended South East Busway to Springwood and the new Rochedale bus station and park 'n' ride, also delivered as part of the milestone project for South East Queenslanders.
