Maritime Safety Queensland set to commence Stage 2 of essential structural repairs at Wellington Point Jetty

Maritime Safety Queensland (MSQ) is undertaking crucial repairs on the popular Wellington Point Jetty to restore safe and unrestricted access to the jetty.

Following initial stabilisation works undertaken in late 2024, MSQ will be progressing with substantial repairs over the next few months. These works will ensure the facility remains fit for purpose, is safe for all users will extend the life of this iconic jetty.

The works are being carried out by South-East Queensland based contractor Mitchell Marine Constructions Pty Ltd. Construction is planned to begin on Monday 16 June with completion expected in December 2025, weather and site conditions permitting.

The scope of works includes replacement of girders and cross beams (headstocks) on several spans, repairs to piles, replacement of aging decking and painting of handrails.

In the best interests of public safety and efficiency for the contractor, the jetty will be closed for public access during this time.

Maritime Safety Queensland has scheduled these works to be undertaken in the winter months for minimal disruption and would like to thank the community for their patience and cooperation during this important work.

Please use extra caution around the worksite both on the land side and in-water.
