Public urged to exercise caution as widespread flooding plagues Western and Northern Queensland

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is urging the public to exercise extra caution on the roads as Western and Northern Queensland face widespread flooding.

Road users are being reminded that “if it’s flooded, forget it”, as a widespread weather system brings rain from the interior to the east coast.

Severe weather warnings continue to be in place with more rain expected across most of the State for the rest of the week and into the weekend.

TMR urges road users to drive to conditions and follow the directions of traffic controllers and temporary signage.

Further updates and advice on travel and road conditions will continue to be communicated by the relevant authorities. TMR remains committed to the public’s safety and ensuring the reliability of our road network.
