Safer speeds for the Bundaberg region

- TMR is responding to community requests to reduce the speed limit at two locations within the Bundaberg region.
- A section of Bundaberg Ring Road between Goodwood Road and Kay McDuff Drive at Thabeban and a section of Goodwood Road between Langbeckers and the Thomasens Road and Douglas Road intersection will be reduced from 100km/hr to 80km/hr.
- Changes follow a review of the speed limit at both locations looking at road conditions and crash history.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is responding to community requests and will reduce the speed limit at two locations in the Bundaberg region to improve safety for motorists.

Sections along Bundaberg Ring Road between Goodwood Road and Kay McDuff Drive, Thabeban and Goodwood Road between Langbeckers and the Thomasens Road and Douglas Road intersection will be reduced from 100km/hr to 80km/hr.

The new speed limits have been endorsed by the local Speed Management Committee, comprising representatives from TMR, local government and Queensland Police.

Transport and Main Roads Regional Director (Southern Queensland Region), Bill Lansbury, said the speed limit changes were endorsed by the Speed Management Committee after considering several factors.

“TMR undertook a review of the speed limit at both locations, taking into consideration a range of factors such as road function, roadside environment, road construction standards, prevailing traffic speeds and crash history,” Mr Lansbury said.

“The new signs are expected to be installed within the coming months, weather and other conditions permitting.

“I encourage all motorists to observe the new speed limit signage and to always drive to the conditions.”
