Safety first as design progresses for busy intersection in Elimbah

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is progressing design to signalise the intersection of Beerburrum Road, Twin View Road and English Street, Elimbah.

Traffic signals will control turning movements at the intersection, improving safety.

Signalising the intersection will help all road users, including pedestrians, to navigate this busy intersection.

Design is expected to be completed in late 2025. Key stakeholders and the community will be updated following completion of the design.

The proposed project scope includes:

- a new signalised intersection including:
 - two new signalised pedestrian crossings
 - dedicated right-turn lanes into Twin View Road English Street
- improvements to pedestrian footpaths and kerb ramps
- active transport improvements
- adjust existing and install new lighting.

The \$5.9 million project has been funded under the Queensland Government's Targeted Safety Program which aims to improve road safety by implementing high-benefit, cost-effective road treatments at known and potential crash locations.
