### **Safety first for Woody Point intersections**

The Queensland Government is progressing plans to improve safety at the intersections of Brighton–Redcliffe Road (Hornibrook Esplanade) and Oxley Avenue in Woody Point.

These upgrades are part of the Queensland Government’s Targeted Road Safety Program – Safer Roads Sooner initiative – which focuses on delivering critical safety improvements across the state.

The project prioritises the safety of all road users at these key intersections at Woody Point, which have experienced a number of traffic crashes.

This key route into the Redcliffe Peninsula is located close to schools and community facilities. This project will provide safer crossing opportunities for the pedestrians visiting the Woody Point village and foreshore.

As part of the project, both intersections will be signalled to minimise the risk of crashes.

Additionally, with high traffic volumes along Oxley Avenue into Hornibrook Esplanade, these changes will provide motorists with a dedicated phase to complete turn movements safely.

This upgrade also enables the installation of new signalised pedestrian crossings at both intersections. These dedicated crossings will create safer passages for the community to access the Woody Point foreshore.
