Safety improvements for Warrego intersection at Helidon Spa

- The Queensland Government is preparing to undertake safety improvements at the Warrego Highway and Warrego Highway service road intersection.
- To improve traffic flow and safety, the project will remove right-turn movements, close the centre median, install new signage, and create a new left-turn exit from James Norman Hedges Park.
- This project is funded through the Department of Transport and Main Roads' Safer Roads Sooner program, supporting safer infrastructure for regional communities.

The Queensland Government is progressing plans to improve safety at the intersection of the Warrego Highway and the Warrego Highway service road, leading to the James Norman Hedges Park at Helidon Spa.

The project will involve the design and construction of several key safety upgrades, including:

- Removal of the existing right-turn in and right-turn out movements at the Warrego Highway and Service Road intersection.
- Closure of the centre median on the Warrego Highway at the intersection.
- Installation of new signage to inform road users of the changed access arrangements to James Norman Hedges Park.
- Construction of a new exit from James Norman Hedges Park to enable a safe left-turn onto the Warrego Highway.

These improvements aim to reduce the risk of crashes and enhance traffic flow along this busy section of the Warrego Highway.

Funding for the project has been provided through the Queensland Government's Safer Roads Sooner program.

The Queensland Government is committed to delivering safer road infrastructure for Queensland communities and will continue to engage with stakeholders throughout the project's development.
