Safety improvements on the way for busy Deception Bay intersection

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is progressing to the design phase for safety improvements at the intersection of Deception Bay Road, Bay Avenue and Moreton Downs Drive in Deception Bay.

The project will involve the removal of left-turn slip lanes and associated traffic islands. Signalised left-turn lanes and new pedestrian crossings will control turning movements at the intersection, improving safety and reducing the potential for crashes.

With the busy intersection in close proximity to Deception Bay Bus Station, Deception Bay State High School and the Market Square Retail Precinct, a focus of the project is to provide safer and more direct crossing opportunities for pedestrians, including school children who regularly cross these roads. The project will also look to provide more inclusive pedestrian infrastructure.

The \$8.34 million project is being funded under the Queensland Government's Targeted Road Safety Program, which aims to improve road safety by implementing high-benefit, cost-effective treatments.

Key stakeholders and the community will be updated following completion of the design, expected for early 2026.
