## **Safety works to start on southbound Sunshine Coast Motorway bridges at Pacific Paradise**

Construction work will soon start on two southbound Sunshine Motorway bridges located above the David Low Way interchange at Pacific Paradise, to remove and replace asphalt and damaged concrete safety barriers.

The works are scheduled to begin in mid-February 2025 and are expected to be completed by late April 2025, weather and construction conditions permitting.

The majority of work will be undertaken during the day, with both southbound lanes of the Sunshine Motorway open to traffic. For the safety of motorists, and to allow for the work to be undertaken, a reduced speed limit of 40km/h will be in place through the work zone on the Sunshine Motorway.

Motorists can expect delays whilst these works are underway and are advised to allow additional travel time.

Some intermittent night works will require the temporary closure of the southbound Sunshine Motorway bridges. A temporary diversion utilising the Sunshine Motorway/David Low Way interchange slip lanes will be in place for motorists travelling southbound. Any changed traffic conditions will be communicated to motorists via variable messaging signs.
