TMR Community Media Alert

South East Queensland major roads and bridges update

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) confirms there are no major road, bridge or tunnel closures currently in place across South East Queensland.

TMR will not pre-emptively close bridges and roads in the lead up to Tropical Cyclone Alfred.

The combination of increased wind and rain can significantly impact safe travel because visibility will reduce.

TMR strongly encourages all motorists and pedestrians in South East Queensland to drive according to conditions, reduce speeds and, as the weather worsens, avoid unnecessary travel.

TMR will notify the public if any other road, bridge, or pedestrian connection is impacted by debris or damage via QLDTraffic.

Heavy vehicle operators should always make judgements about whether their specific vehicles are safe to operate in any windy conditions that prevail.

TMR is actively monitoring the situation and is ready to act.
