Warwick-Allora Road to get safety upgrades

The Department of Transport and Main Roads is improving safety for pedestrians on Warwick-Allora Road at Warwick State High School.

Eight raised pedestrian crossings, nicknamed wombat crossings, are being constructed at the Victoria Street and Palmerin and Guy streets roundabouts.

A raised crossing encourages traffic to slow down and improves visibility, safety and accessibility for people crossing the road.

The Queensland Government has invested \$1.79 million through the Targeted Road Safety Program to design and construct the wombat crossings.

A mid-block crossing was installed on Victoria Street last year, as part of the Queensland Government's School Transport Infrastructure Program which delivers minor infrastructure projects to improve road safety at schools for their communities.

Works are scheduled to start this month and be completed late-2025, weather and construction conditions permitting.
