Works commence to replace damaged culvert at Perseverance Creek, Esk-Hampton Road

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is starting work to replace a damaged culvert on Esk–Hampton Road at Perseverance Creek, with a temporary two-lane side track constructed to keep the road open during construction.

From Monday 25 August 2025, all traffic on Esk–Hampton Road will be diverted on to the side track between Perseverance Hall Road and Church House Road.

There will be a speed reduction to 40km/hr and minor delays for all vehicles travelling on the side track.

It is expected that the side track will be in operation for approximately eight months while the culvert is being replaced, weather and construction conditions permitting.

TMR will continue to consult with directly affected stakeholders throughout the project.

This project is being delivered under the Queensland Government's State Road Network Upgrade Program – State-wide Structures Upgrades (major culvert subprogram).
