Works to upgrade signals at major Toowoomba intersections to get underway

Works to upgrade traffic signals at two major Toowoomba intersections will get underway later this month and are expected to be completed by August 2025.

The intersections to have upgraded traffic signals include James Street and West Street, and Bridge Street and Richmond Drive.

Works will take place between 7pm and 6am Sunday to Friday. Some activities may need to be undertaken on Sundays from 3pm to keep noisy works at night to a minimum. Night works will allow the site to be fully re-opened during traffic hours.

The project involves replacing aged and damaged traffic signal hardware, such as traffic poles and electrical pits, and rewiring signals

Access to surrounding properties may be affected by temporary traffic management changes with traffic control signs in place to direct road users through the works safely.

Any single lane closures implemented at night will be reopened by 6am in the morning.

The project is wholly funded by the Queensland Government.
