Moa Island communities invited to information sessions on Kubin and St Pauls jetty repairs

Maritime Safety Queensland is inviting community members, Elders, jetty users and local businesses to information sessions on planned make-safe repairs to the Kubin (Arkai) and St Pauls (Wug) jetties under the Queensland Government's Torres Strait Islands Marine Infrastructure Program.

The sessions will give community members an opportunity to meet the project team, ask questions and learn more about the planned works.

The Kubin and St Pauls jetties are part of the Torres Strait's Blue Highway — the marine transport network connecting island communities to essential services, freight, education, health care, culture, family and Country.

The repairs will help restore safer jetty access and support ongoing marine transport connections for the Kubin and St Pauls communities.
