Repair works set to commence on Weinam Street Jetty

The Queensland Government will undertake repair works to the Weinam Street Jetty in Redland Bay to maintain the facility and ensure it remains safe and fit for purpose for years to come.

The Weinam Street Jetty is an important local asset supporting recreational boating access to Moreton Bay.

The works include repairs to jetty concrete elements, fender pile repairs, lighting repairs, water tap maintenance and mooring cleat replacement.

The works will enhance safety, maintain recreational boating and fishing access, and preserve the long-term functionality of this valued community asset for the benefit of the local community.

Onsite construction is scheduled to begin in mid-July 2026, following the busy school holiday period, with works expected to be completed by late September 2026, weather and site conditions permitting.

The jetty will be closed for the duration of the works for public safety and to support efficient construction.

Boaties and visitors will be able to use alternative nearby facilities at the Redland City Council owned boat ramps and floating walkway at Weinam Creek, located 2km south of the Weinam Street Jetty.

The Queensland Government asks all waterway users to exercise caution around the worksite, both on land and in surrounding waters.
