Speed limit changes coming to Bundaberg region roads

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) will introduce permanent speed limit changes on several state-controlled roads across the Bundaberg region to improve safety for all road users.

Following speed limit reviews and community feedback, changes will apply to the following roads in both directions of travel:

- Bundaberg – Gin Gin Road (Sharon):
 - A six-kilometre section between Sharon Road and Kurths Road will be reduced to 80km/h.
- Elliott Heads Road:
 - A three-kilometre section between Bundaberg Ring Road and St Johns Road will be reduced to 70km/h. The school zone at Woongarra State School will be reduced to 40km/h during school sone operating times.
 - A three-kilometre section between Innes Park Road and Three Chain Road will be reduced to 80km/h.
- The Cedars Road (Hill End Road):
 - A two-kilometre section between South Bingera Road and north of Cedars Bridge will be reduced to 60km/h.
 - A five-kilometre section between north Cedars Bridge and Bundaberg – Gin Gin Road will be reduced to 80km/h.

The new speed limits will come into effect once new speed limit signs are installed over the coming weeks, weather and other conditions permitting.

The speed limit reviews considered a range of factors, including road function, roadside environment, road design standards, prevailing traffic speeds, crash history and community feedback.

The changes have been endorsed by the Bundaberg Speed Management Committee, which includes representatives from the Queensland Police Service, local government and TMR.

Motorists are reminded to observe the new speed limit signs once they are installed and always drive to the prevailing road conditions.
