Waterford (Larry Storey) boat ramp reconstruction set to begin early June

The Queensland Government will soon begin reconstruction works at the Waterford (Larry Storey) boat ramp, improving safety and access for the local boating community.

Maritime Safety Queensland will deliver the project to ensure the facility continues to meet the needs of both the community and industry.

The project involves reconstructing the existing single-lane boat ramp, extending its length to improve launching and retrieval at lower tides, and constructing new grouted rock shoulders to provide additional stability.

Construction is scheduled to begin in early June, with completion expected by early August 2026, weather and site conditions permitting.

For public safety and to allow construction to be carried out efficiently, the boat ramp will be fully closed for the duration of the works. Alternative access is available at the Federation Drive boat ramp in Bethania, approximately five kilometres north of the site.

The Queensland Government thanks the community for its patience while these works are undertaken to deliver a safer, more accessible facility for local boaties.
