Waterford (Larry Storey) boat ramp upgrade works now complete

The Queensland Government has completed upgrade works at the Waterford (Larry Storey) boat ramp, improving safety and access for the local boating community.

The works have restored and enhanced the single-lane facility, including extending the ramp to support launching and retrieval at lower tides, and constructing new grouted rock shoulders to improve stability and durability.

Maritime Safety Queensland led the delivery of the works to ensure the facility continues to meet the needs of both recreational boaters and industry users.

The boat ramp has reopened to the public, with works completed ahead of the scheduled August 2026 completion date.

Maritime Safety Queensland thanks the community for its patience during the temporary closure and is pleased to deliver a safer, more resilient and reliable boating facility for Waterford that will serve the boating community well into the future.
