Speed reduced on Kenilworth Skyring Creek Road

The speed limit on Gympie's Kenilworth Skyring Creek Road has been reduced to 80km/h in response to community concerns.

Transport and Main Roads Regional Director for Southern Queensland Kym Murphy said a speed limit review considered factors such as road function, roadside environment and crash history.

"We've listened to the community and a reduced speed limit was endorsed by the Speed Management Committee following the review," Ms Murphy said.

"The committee recommended permanently reducing the limit from 100km/h to 80km/h.

"The new speed limit on Kenilworth Skyring Creek Road will be enforced between the Old Bruce Highway and north of Poulsen Road.

"I urge all motorists to observe the new speed signs and to always drive to conditions."

The Speed Management Committee includes representatives from the Queensland Police Service, Gympie Regional Council and Transport and Main Roads.
