

Hi

Thankyou for meeting with me on Monday this week at the Maroochydore Junior Rugby League Grounds.

I undertook to provide you the details around what TMR would support for advertising near the Sunshine Motorway.

As some background, the location of signage along a main road, in this case a motorway, needs to comply with TMR's Roadside Advertising Guide. It is important to locate advertising signs where they do not conflict with driver decision points, potential vehicle conflict points, and official traffic signs.

To meet this requirement, the placement of an advertising sign for northbound traffic entering the motorway on the onramp in this location is not supported by the department due to the proximity of the adjacent merge point on the motorway on-ramps. It is important that drivers have their attention focussed on vehicle movements in this area to reduce the chances of a crash.

The placement of an advertising sign on your property visible to southbound traffic on the motorway is acceptable to the department. The sign location is outside the restriction zones for the off-ramp to Maroochy Boulevard, and there are no official road signs that need to be given priority.

You asked if the club could turn the southern signage face to make a larger size billboard. This would be acceptable to the department provided it only faced the south bound traffic on the motorway.

I have followed up with my technical staff following our meeting who advised the maximum allowable area of a single advertising device is 85m2. Typical sign sizes are shown in the table below.

Table 6.1 - Typical advertising device dimensions

In creating a larger sign at this location it must contain a single advertising message. It is a requirement of TMR's Roadside Advertising Guide that advertising messages visible from a motorway in a 100km/h zone be separated by at least 250m to reduce the level of distraction to drivers.

As the sign is located on the club's property, you will need to gain council approval of your proposal under their local laws.

Also we discussed the possibility of removing some of the regrowth in the road reserve from a small area immediately in front of the existing signage. While TMR usually does not permit removal of vegetation for advertising in the road reserve, I agreed to this as the vegetation was only minor regrowth. When you decide what your options are for the signage, you will need to apply to TMR for a permit to have this area cut. Due to the location and potential traffic interaction, I suggest you engage TMR's road contractor and discuss with the contractor what they may require the club to pay for this service.

I also had a look at the Baptist Church signage further north that you referred to. The location of this sign is not in the same situation as the rugby club. The main difference is the rugby club's sign is located where vehicles are needing to merge. It is not dependent on distance from the property boundary.
