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Road Corridor Permit Conditions:

Conditions specific to this permit

- a) As per attached 'RCP-1339 Structures Conditions'.
- b) Water pipeline route to Lot 72 CTN482 is shown on attached photos and notes.
- c) This permit is not transferrable and would expire upon the sale of Lot 72 CTN482.
- d) As the route of the existing pipeline also traverses an alignment along both Moura Short Railway Line (Aurizon) and Potters Road (Gladstone Regional Council), separate approval from these bodies should be sought.
- e) TMR reserves the right to give notice for the removal of this pipe at permit holders cost should TMR future upgrading works be required. This would require the decommissioning of the existing pipeline across the highway through the 375mm RC pipe under the highway at Ch 42500.
- f) Any changes/additions to the existing pipeline crossing in the state-controlled road reserve will require a new Road Corridor Permit from TMR before any works can commence.

ADVICE:

- a) This approval does not authorise any other approvals/works that might be required
- b) This approval does not dictate ownership to any infrastructure forming part of this approval

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RCP-1339 STRUCTURES CONDITIONS

General

- The Company is to construct the structure at no cost to the Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR).
- 2. Written acceptance or commencement of construction works shall be deemed acceptance by the Company of all conditions of this Approval.
- 3. TMR shall not be held liable for any delay, associated or consequential cost due, but not limited to, any approval, notification, opinion or decision in relation to a change or clarification in respect of the construction of the works.
- 4. The RCP cannot be transferred to someone else.
- 5. The Company must keep a complete copy of the RCP and any other approvals on site at all times.
- 6. The Company is to comply with all other laws and requirements that may apply to the Company's works, including but not limited to:
 - a. obtaining approvals from other agencies; and
 - b. complying with the *Work Health and Safety Act 2011* and Regulations, and the *Environmental Protection Act 1994* (including the Company's environmental duty).
- 7. The Company must not damage TMR roads, or anything within TMR roads. The Company should contact public utility providers in the area to locate their services prior to construction. If the Company damages TMR's roads or anything within it, TMR may direct that the Company reinstate it to a reasonable standard, or pay all reasonable costs for TMR to do so.
- 8. The Company must not interfere with existing drainage, signage, road markers or anything else within TMR's roads.
- The Company must contact the department's Traffic Systems Coordinator on 07 4931 1565 should any
 works be conducted near traffic signals and/or associated infrastructure, prior to the commencement of
 works.
- 10. The Company must remove any litter generated as part of the Company's activity.
- 11. TMR makes no warrant as to the existence or non-existence of native title interests over any land within the boundaries of the state-controlled road proposed for construction works. It is a requirement of this Approval that the owner of the proposed works complies with Section 24JB subsection 6 of the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cwth).
- 12. The Company is to provide TMR with the details of any contractor and their authority.

Indemnity, Security and Insurances

- 13. The Company must provide TMR with a signed Deed of Indemnity before the commencement of works.
- 14. The Company must insure and keep insured, during the Term of this Approval and any extension of the Term, all improvements to the Land and things brought on the Site for the purpose of carrying out works under this Approval, against damage or loss of any kind. The insurance must be:
 - a. in the name of the Company for its rights and interests, to the satisfaction of TMR and noting TMR as an interested party;
 - b. for a sum not less than the full reinstatement value of the improvements, the road, all elements of the road including the pavement and things brought on the site.



Existence and Maintenance of Structure

- 15. Water pipeline entry point at corner of Potters Road/Catfish Road outside Not relevant (72/CTN482).
- 16. Water pipeline located all way along the boundary of 2/RP620042 along Potters Road at 2 metres from boundary line towards Moura Short Railway Line and then through a culvert located on the eastern side of existing OLC.
- 17. Water pipeline continuing along northern side of Potters Road towards Dawson Highway within A/AP12224 for a crossing point on Dawson Highway (existing 375mm RC pipe located at Ch 42500 approx 150 metres east of Potters Road turnoff).
- 18. No later than ten (10) business days before starting any maintenance activity in the vicinity of the pipe crossing of the highway, the Company must:
 - a. contact TMR to arrange a pre-start meeting for the maintenance; and
 - b. inform TMR of the details of the Principal Contractor for the workplace.
- 19. No later than ten (10) business days prior to commencement of maintenance of the structure, the Company must provide TMR with site specific approved Traffic Management Plans (TMPs).
- 20. The maintenance must be completed within **1 month** from the date of the maintenance pre start meeting.
- 21. Maintenance of the structure is to proceed without unreasonable interruption to through traffic, cyclists and pedestrians. This includes taking all steps necessary to protect the public during the maintenance by providing adequate traffic management or other specified protection in accordance with TMR's Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (2003), Part 3- Works on Road (MUTCD Part3).
- 22. The Company is responsible for ensuring that road safety is maintained when working within TMR's road.
- 23. TMR may audit any part of the work and will recover the reasonable cost of any audits that confirm sub standard workmanship or a divergence from the approved/submitted plans.
- 24. The Company must inform TMR 48 hours after completion of the maintenance.

Cessation of Activity

- 25. No later than three (3) months after the cessation of all use and operation of the structure the company shall:
 - a. remove and dispose of the structure and all superficial road surfacing materials;
 - b. treat disturbed areas to prevent erosion and sediment loss.
 - c. restore the state-controlled road to its pre-existing condition.
- 26. The Company shall contact TMR within ten (10) business days of having completed removal works to arrange a joint site inspection. If the Company does not remove the structure within this time frame, TMR can remove the structure and recover the cost of removal from the Company.

TMR's powers

- 27. TMR may direct the Company to alter, relocate, make safe or remove the Company's structure if the structure is, or may in the future:
 - a. create a traffic hazard; or
 - b. reduce safety; or
 - c. have an adverse effect on traffic operations.

The Company will bear all costs associated with any direction given under Condition 49 above.

- (b) The Company releases and discharges the Department from all actions, proceedings, claims, demands, costs, losses, damages, liabilities and expense which but for the provisions hereof might be brought against the Department, arising from the use of the Land by the Company, its employees, contractors, sub-contractors, agents and other representatives and any works or activities carried out by the Company, its employees, contractors, sub-contractors, agents and other representatives under this approval or decision.
- (c) The Indemnity in clause (a) continues in full force and effect at all times in which the Company or any employee, contractor, subcontractor, representative or assignee of otherwise of the Company occupies or otherwise uses the Land as contemplated by this approval or decision.
